Primary teaching responsibilities include supply chain topics across all levels of our academic programs. The expected teaching load for Assistant Professors is three courses per academic year and four for Associate Professors, with a one-course teaching release for very good research productivity. The Price College of Business (PCB) at OU continues to flourish. The Price College of Business is AACSB-accredited, with approximately 5,500 undergraduate, 820 master's, and 42 doctoral students. Its undergraduate program is ranked 64th by U.S. News and World Report, and its full-time and professional MBA programs are ranked 86th and 89th, respectively.
